- More framework (AWP) opportunities;
- as a way of creating opportunities for smaller providers the Government is encouraging purchasers to establish frameworks and to also divide large contracts into a number of Lots;
- the introduction of the "mega-framework";
- more opportunities resulting from increased outsourcing of health services;
- a general contraction of about one third in the value of contracts on re-tendering; increased competition leading to a general improvement in the quality of tenders; contrary to some reports, larger providers losing out to small and medium organisations;
- some large national organisations retaining fewer than 50% of re-tendered contracts;
- changes to tender requirements leading to new, technical tender writing skills what worked in tender preparation at the end of 2011 is unlikely to work in 2012/13
